### **GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE CAMP**

This will be a 3 day fly fishing and tying camp. Previous fly fishing experience is not required. Your child will receive casting instruction on the first night and, fishing thereafter. Participants will receive fly tying experience after dinner on the first and second evenings of the program. On the second morning, they will learn about entomology (bugs), will capture specimens, and will attempt to imitate live bug patterns during the fly tying class on the second evening. They will fish almost all day when not receiving instruction or eating. Rods, reels, fly line, leaders, tippet, fishing packs, hats, buffs, fly patterns, fly boxes and related accessories are provided to all participants. Fishing boots and waders are not required, although participants are urged to bring sturdy shoes that can get wet and that provide support, a light wind/rain jacket and layered clothing. Dinner will be provided on the first and second days, and breakfast and lunch will be provided on the second and third days. Separate lodging for boys and girls will be provided in separate facilities that are approximately ½ mile from each other. Lodging will be cabins and/or apartments on location. Girls will have women mentors and boys will have male mentors with a ratio of approximately 1:3 or less. Participants only need to bring a sleeping bag, a pillow, if desired, personal clothing, and personal hygiene items. Participants will be supervised at all times.

This event is limited to 12 Utah participants, and enrollments are taken on a first-come, first served basis. After the first 12 Utah participants have enrolled, additional participants will be placed on a wait list in the order their applications are received. Guardians will be responsible for drop off and pick up at Paradise Ranch. At pick-up on the third day you will be given the opportunity to fish with your child for a few hours and, if desired, have dinner at the Ranch for an optional additional cost. All adult mentors and volunteers undergo and are required to pass police background checks prior to receiving approval to participate in the program, and are experienced fly fishers.

Cost for this event will be \$350.00 per participant and payment in advance is due upon submission of this form. The cost is fully refundable if the participant cancels within 90 days prior to the start of the camp, and ½ is refundable if cancellation occurs within 45 days of the camp. The balance of the cost is refundable if, after cancellation, another participant enrolls and pays the full cost. Guardians also will need to sign a standard release form and both guardians and participants will need to sign a photo waiver as our sponsor's would like the option to use any of the photos taken.

June 26, 2017 – Participants arrive. Guardians drop off participants at Sportsman’s Paradise, Paradise UT.

- a. 2 p.m. arrival time. Camp begins
- b. 3 p.m. - Meet and greet. – Participants receive their gear.
- c. 3:30 – 5:00 – Casting instruction, with some fishing possible with mentors
- d. 5:00 – 6:00 p.m. -Dinner
- e. 6:00 – 7:30 p.m. – Practice casting and more fishing with mentors
- f. 8:00 – 9:30 p.m. – Fly tying lessons (fly tying equipment will be provided)
- g. 9:30 p.m. – lights out

June 27, 2017

- a. 6:00 -7:00 a.m. Breakfast and discussion about what we are doing for the day.
- b. 7:30 a.m. -noon - Fishing with mentors
- c. Noon – 1:00 p.m. Lunch and discussion about the morning
- d. 1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. entomology lesson and bug hunting / capture. (nets and specimen gars will be provided)
